I'm pleased to announce that early registration is [open](#) for the **2021 Fall RSL season!** RSL is the non-travel recreational division of Radnor Soccer Club. Our fall RSL programs are designed to introduce competitive soccer to our youngest players as well as provide a forum for older age-group players to play and enhance their skills without the commitment level of travel soccer. RSL 2021 Fall Program Overview and Eligibility:

- RSL is open to all youth athletes, Pre-K through 12th-Grade, that are looking to learn the sport, improve their skillset, have fun, and enjoy competitive community-level soccer. RSL encourages players to play multiple sports and provides the perfect environment for youth athletes that want to enjoy soccer while maintaining their involvement in other fall sports activities.
- RSL participation includes one week night practice and one game every Saturday throughout the course of the season.
- The program is led by dedicated volunteers who work closely with our RSL Director of Coaching and professional coaches to provide a structured training curriculum that affords our players the ability to develop into strong, confident individuals who appreciate teamwork, commitment, and pride in being a part of the Radnor Soccer Club.
- Programs are open to non-residents of Radnor Township and we welcome players from across the southeast PA region to play.

New This Fall:

- Following the success of our RSL Spring Clinic program, we've made the decision to expand our fall season age group availability and are excited to introduce a new Pre-K division to the RSL fall program for Pre-K children ages 4 and 5!

Season Dates:

- The season is scheduled to begin the first Saturday after Labor Day and will run through mid-November (weather permitting). Games will be held every Saturday and practices will one night per week.

2021 Fees and Other Information:

- Early registration (June 7th – June 30th) - \$185 per player.
- Regular registration (July 1st – July 31st) - \$195 per player.
- Late registrations (after July 31st) will be available as space permits and incur a \$10 processing fee atop the regular registration fee.
- *Players will receive a team jersey and additional team equipment as part of their registration fee.*

Early registration is strongly encouraged for us to have an idea of the player counts for each age group and ensure adequate time to work with the other Radnor youth sports to coordinate field times and schedules for those players who are playing multiple sports. All players will receive a team jersey and additional team equipment as part of their registration fee.
