Rob Dallas begins his ninth season as Cabrini 's head men's soccer coach in 2020-21. Dallas was named head coach in January 2012 after six seasons as an assistant coach with the Cabrini men's soccer team.

Since Dallas joined the program in 2006 the Cavaliers have amassed a record of (178-99-21). Since Dallas has taken over as the head coach, the Cavaliers have reached the conference championship match in 2012, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, & 2019, securing conference titles and NCAA tournament births in 2012, 2015, and 2017. The Cavaliers reached unprecedented heights in 2017 as the program scored its first ever win in the NCAA Tournament with a dramatic 1-0 overtime win over Rowan.

During Dallas' time on the Cavaliers' sideline, his responsibilities have included all aspects of recruiting, scouting opponents, in-season and off-season training and player development, budget management and ensuring that student-athletes adhere to Cabrini and NCAA policies.

In addition to his time at Cabrini, Dallas also has extensive experience coaching at the club level. Dallas has coached in several local youth soccer organizations including FC Delco, FCUSA, and currently in Radnor Soccer Club.

After graduating in 2000 from Radnor High School, Dallas went on to continue his playing career with the Division II Millersville University soccer program from 2000-03. Dallas graduated with a bachelor's degree in Education and a minor in Athletic Coaching.
